No competitor may ride more than one pony in any W.H.P class.

Classes 47-50 to be judged in line with BSPS rules and are two phase, 70% for jumping performance and 30% for manners, conformation, type and freedom of action. No change of saddlery will be permitted throughout the competition. Any suitable bridle may be worn. Spurs are forbidden and whip not to exceed 30ins in length.

**Class 46 Leadrein/Assisted Wobbly Working Hunter Pony**

Ponies not to have won any BSJA money. Height of fences not to exceed 1ft 3". Ponies can be led. Special rosette for best child under 12 years.

**Class 47 Green Working Hunter Pony**

Ponies not to have won any BSJA money. Height of fences not to exceed 2ft".

**Class 48 Novice Working Hunter Pony/M&M Working Hunter pony**

Ponies not to have been placed 1<sup>st</sup> – 3<sup>rd</sup> in any WH class, not to have won more than £30 BSJA. Height of fences not to exceed 2ft 6ins

**Class 49 Open Working Hunter Pony**

Height of fences not to exceed 3ft

### Working Hunter Pony Championship for 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> in Classes 46-49.

**Class 50 Clemmie/BHS Scotland Riding Club Style Jumping Series 2017. Judge: Mrs Dorothy Burnett**

Course max 85cm. Open to horses 4yo and over, not to have won more than £175 BS or have more than 10 BE points. Riders 18yo on 1st Jan and not to have competed under FEI rules, be FBHS or have sat BHSII exams in last 10 years. Run under BRC rules. To be eligible to compete at the final riders must be a senior member of a riding club affiliated to BRC. Prize winners are not eligible for any championship.

Winners do not qualify for Supreme Championship

**Class 51 Green Working Hunter**

For horses exceeding 153cm and over, and 4 years old or over which have never been placed 1st to 3rd in any Working Hunter competition. To be judged on style, conformation and may be asked to give a display. Max. height of fences 2'3".

**Class 52 Novice Working Hunter**

For horses exceeding 153cm and over, and 4 years old or over, which have not been placed 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> in any Working Hunter competition more than 3 times or won more than £100 in BSJA affiliated competitions. Max. height of fences 2'9". To be judged on the same basis as class 51.

**Class 53 BHS Scotland/Eastern BMW Building Services BRC Working Hunter Series 2017**

Horses must be 15hh and over. Horses must not have won more than £400 in total in any WH competitions, more than £400 in BS winnings or have more than 45 BE points. Riders must be 18yo or over on 1 Jan 2017.

**TO QUALIFY RIDERS MUST BE MEMBERS OF A RIDING CLUB**

Eight to twelve fences up to 3ft 3ins. Class will be judged under Sports Horse Breeding of Great Britain rules. The first 3 (with a clear round) qualify for the final to be held at Blair Castle in August.

- Class 69 Costume Concours D'Elegance:** Open to Side Saddle and Astride riders!! Judged on costume, elegance and harmony of horse/pony and rider in costume
